Project Description:

The orphanages accommodate children in need and children, who have lost their parents and find themselves in a difficult and desperate situation. Aim of the project is to improve the care and education of socially disadvantaged children in order to increase their future living conditions. It consists in supporting the orphanage staff with fulfilling their duties. Due to the lack of money, there not enough orphanage staff. So the childrens needs cannot be satisfied adequately. Thats the reason why voluntary work is absolutely necessary.

Work: The volunteer will assist the orphanage staff with their daily tasks, as for example: Take care of the children in their daily life: food, clothing, hygiene Take time to listen to the children, to encourage them and to restore hope Organize games as well as literacy and development activities Realise educational activities Organize trips Stimulate the childrens development

Requirements: The volunteers dont need any special qualification to bring their humanitarian help to these unfortunate children. Patience, optimism, open-mindedness, listening, initiative, etc.

Food: Provided by ASTOVOT.

Accommodation: In host families.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Volunteer has to get his/her own insurance.

Fees: 290 EUR per month. Administrative costs, food and accommodation.

Visa: You need a visa to go to Togo. Information is available at the Togo embassy or consulate in your country. It is possible to obtain a visa at the airport but we recommend that you get in your country to avoid administrative complications.

Others: If possible, the volunteer can bring educational material, books, dvds, toys, etc.
