Fees: 240 EUR per month. 40%:During LMTV (OAT,meals,accommodation,project materials,local transport, emergency) 60%:pre-post LMTV (need assessment,meeting with local partners,stakeholders)&donation to organisation: PV training, basic training, fees for IVS networks
