Project Description:

Investments in early child development through supportive care, early learning activities and improved school readiness along with health and nutrition interventions increases the likelihood that boys and girls will complete primary school and even further. The overarching goal of early learning is to ensure disadvantaged children enter school on time and are cognitively, socially and emotionally ready for school.

Work: Assisting local teachers/staff in teaching basic arithmetic, writing, reading and drawing. Organizing games, sports and other children's activities that support their learning and growth. Preparing meals for kids and help feeding when necessary. Supporting local teachers/staff in developing their capacity through English language classes. Children management and lesson plans. Flexibility is required since more activities might be added.

Requirements: Interested to work with children 31 Interested in other cultures Eager to learn and share Patient and committed Creative and flexible Open minded and good team player Ability to work under less supervision and minimum resources. Ability to express oneself in English.

Food: Meals and accommodation will be provided for for the whole period of the project.

Accommodation: The volunteers will be accommodated in host families.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: VOLU will not provide insurances for the volunteers. Insurance is needed.

Fees: 250 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport/bus station, orientation, evaluation, monitoring, project set up, administrative expenses, supporting small community projects, running of activities during the project, certificate of participation, accommodation, food.

Visa: To stay 3 5 months an open tourist visa or business visa is required. VOLU will provide an invitation letter on request when the application is confirmed. We recommend that volunteers prepare all necessary documents to obtain visas themselves.

Others: Volunteers should bring along the following: mosquito net, medication, flash light, bed sheet, games, musical instruments, social/casual dresses, toiletries, sandals and shoes for their personal use, working shoes (Boots).

Volunteers are allowed to stay in the VOLU office Hostel for two weeks free of charge (one week before the project starts, and one week after the project), but will pay 10 euros for each day after this period (excl food).
