Project Description:

Treasured Totos KinderCare and Junior School was founded on 1st January 2018 with a vision to provide quality education for equipping persons with globally relevant knowledge, skills and values to transform their lives. Our school admits learners of age 3 years to 12 years of all social, economic and religious backgrounds

Work: The volunteer will work hand in hand with the full-time staff by participating in any or all of the following activities: Preparing teaching resources Supervising and engaging in indoor and outdoor games Music, Dance and Drama Arts and Crafts Engaging children in enjoyable literature through reading, storytelling or other. Documentation of childrens learning Arranging for teachers and parents workshops Any other activity that the volunteer possesses and is relevant/ beneficial to our learning community.

Requirements: We desire to work with a volunteer who will observe our values in addition to exhibiting the following qualities: Passion and enthusiasm for

children Patience and flexibility Friendliness Open mindedness Sense of humor Honesty, Care and Reliability Respect for differences in personality and culture Willingness to learn and share knowledge and experiences

Food: Volunteers prepare their own food. UPA provides gas cooker, a fridge, and utensils. Alternatively, a volunteer can stay with a host family to be more exposed to the Ugandan culture.

Accommodation: The volunteer has the possibility to choose between staying in the guesthouse, with different international volunteers (sharing room, normally 2-4 people) or to stay in a host family. Accommodation is at the UPA Guesthouse, average but not luxury.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: The volunteer is required to come with his/her insurance

Fees: 500 EUR one time payment. The fee covers pickup from the airport or bus station upon arrival in Uganda, orientation, guesthouse maintenance, and administration costs of UPA

Visa: Volunteers must apply for a tourist visa online with this link. <https://www.visas.immigration.g>. This should be done a couple of weeks or months before the departure date. Please refer to infosheet.

Others: 500 Euros shall be paid on arrival for one to three months .If the volunteer is to stay for more than 3 months, 80 euros are paid per extra month in advance.
